### 6/11 Day 1 :

Genesis 22:16-18 The Lord said, "I swear by myself, declares the LORD, that because you have done this and have not withheld your son, your only son, I will surely bless you and make your descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as the sand on the seashore. Your descendants will take possession of the cities of their enemies, and through your offspring all nations on earth will be blessed, because you have obeyed me.

We can see from God's promise to Abraham that God's will is for all nations on earth to be blessed because of Christ's salvation.

- May God open up the hearts of all our participating brothers and sisters, so that we can understand God's heart for missions and to put in our best effort to fulfil His commission.
- God promised and enabled Abraham's descendants to take possession of the cities of their enemies, may God grant all participants a brave heart and to take away all fear, because the Lord is victorious and has given us the authority to be victorious as well.

### 7/11 Day 2:

Luke 4:18-19 The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor.

The core essence of the Bible is the salvation through Jesus Christ's sacrifice on the cross. The good news of this Gospel requires us to boldly share.

- May the anointing of the Spirit fill us, and God to fill us with strength so that we can go the needy ones in Ubon and to spread the Gospel to the poor, and for those in bondage to be released, and for the blind to see, and the oppressed to be free.
- May God grant us a heart of humility and gentleness so that during the mission trip we can share in their joys and pain, as we empathise and understand their difficulties and vulnerabilities.

### 8/11 Day 3:

Acts 2:17-18 'And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams; even on my male servants and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit, and they shall prophesy.

The Holy Spirit came upon the disciples during Pentecost, and they began their work with the Spirit and boldly spread the Gospel. Miraculous things followed wherever they went.

- Pray that all of us be filled with the Spirit, and that we be guided by and work hand in hand with the Spirit during our Ubon mission trip.
- May God grant us various gifts and strengths, so that in our evangelism we do not depend on ourselves, but the power of the Holy Spirit, and that even miracles will happen within us.

### 9/11 Day 4:

Psalms 22:27 All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations shall worship before you.

The population of Thailand stands at 67.9 million, with about 30+ races, with the Thai being the majority, including the Lao people, the Chinese, the Malays, etc. More than 90% of the population are Buddhists, and is a Buddhist country. This is a land where many have not received the Gospel.

- Dear Lord, your will is for all to remember you, and all the nations to worship you. Thailand still has many who have not received the Gospel, may your revival and salvation reach them so that many more can turn towards you.
- May God raise a revival for the churches in Thailand, and to strengthen the work of the missionaries there. May the churches be salt and light there, and lead more people back towards God.

**10/11 Day 5:**

1 Tim 2:4 who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Ubon is situated in the most North-Eastern part of Thailand, and also the first places in Thailand to see the sunrise. With an area of 16,113km<sup>2</sup>, and a total population of 1.83 million (as of 2013), Ubon is Thailand's third largest population centre.

- Ubon is one of Thailand's most populated province, yet many still do not know God. May God's salvation come upon these people, so that many are saved and can come to know the truth.
- May God use the whole YWAM team, so that they can see the needs of different people, and work together with the Spirit and bless more people and turn them towards God.

**11/11 Day 6:**

Psalms 90:17 Let the favor[d] of the Lord our God be upon us, and establish the work of our hands upon us; yes, establish the work of our hands!

YWAM Ubon was founded in 2007, which consisted of only one family, one ministry worker and one volunteer then. They focused mainly on social, school, and training local churches and interacted with youths through these. Now, the ministry have developed into an international missionary organisation, and full-time ministry workers come from 8 different countries, with their ministry spanning neighbouring provinces and countries.

- Thank God for the protection and grace over YWAM Ubon in these years, such that the team continues to grow and experienced His grace. May God continue to use this whole team.
- May God continue to use the YWAM team to serve the youths of Ubon, and may God raise up local leaders and to serve together with YWAM and build the Kingdom of Christ.

**12/11 Day 7:**

1 Corinthians 12:14 For the body does not consist of one member but of many.

In the Kingdom of Christ, the different parts of the body plays different roles. Pray for the cooperation between YWAM and the churches in Ubon.

- May God use YWAM as they work together and serve God's Kingdom with local churches and Christian organisations. May they become blessings to the people, and bring more people to believe in Christ.
- May God protect and watch over the unity between YWAM, the local churches, and the Christian organisations, and remove any obstructive influences and lies from the evil one.

**13/11 Day 8:**

Joshua 1:3 Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given to you, just as I promised to Moses.

God had promised Joshua, that when the Israelites were willing to obey and follow God's will, and respond in faith, God will entrust the promised land to them. YWAM has a land project, which aims to build an orphanage and shelter for abandoned babies. They have to look towards God in faith, and depend on Him for what they are lacking.

- In this land project, which aims to build a shelter and orphanage, may God provide the financial and material needs.
- They will also be building a missionary training centre, do pray for the needs of this project, and for God to provide.

**14/11 Day 9:**

Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

YWAM has a prayer meeting every Wednesday night at 9pm, where they pray for Ubon, Thailand, and other countries of the world, as well as the lost. They have a vision, which is to birth a House of Prayer through these prayer meetings.

- May God grant them spiritual insight, that they can understand the guidance of the Holy Spirit and intercede for the lost, as well as experience His power in their worship.
- May God grant them fellow workers who are blessed with worship and prayer, so that they can experience God's presence in their prayer and worship, and experience the victorious Spirit.

**15/11 Day 10:**

1 Corinthians 12:18 But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose. " There is only one body of Christ, yet with numerous members. May we build each other up and perform our duties.

- May God grant YWAM Ubon suitable workers and perform their duties diligently as they thrive in the Gospel together.
- May God grant them humble hearts, and to connect with one another with gentleness and love, and to build up the whole team.

**16/11 Day 11:**

Matthew 9:35 And Jesus went throughout all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction.

Jesus had already set an example for us with his 3.5 years of ministry here, as he walked through various villages and cities, and taught in various synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the Kingdom of Heaven, healed all sorts of illnesses, so that all could know of God's works.

- May God bless the YWAM team's outreach and missions, so that when they spread the Gospel in other cities, they have heavenly authority to heal and exorcise, so that others can see God's miraculous works.
- May the Spirit anoint their ministry, so that when they are serving those in need, miracles will follow and heavenly healing will come upon them.

**17/11 Day 12:**

James 1:27 Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world.

YWAM Ubon is serving in the homeless ministry, and takes care of those who are homeless, so that they can feel the love and care from God.

- May God provide enough resources, so that YWAM Ubon will not be lacking and can use these resources to help even more homeless people.
- May God use them, not only with their material help, but also to spread the Gospel and message of salvation to these poor and homeless people, so that they can know Jesus.

**18/11 Day 13:**

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

The Gospel brings hope to people. YWAM Ubon also participates in prison ministry, and spreads the hope of the Gospel to those who are in prison.

- May God grant them a strong and courageous heart, and to bravely witness for the Lord in prison, and bring the good news of the Gospel to those who need it.
- May God soften the hearts of those serving sentences, so that when they hear the Gospel, they will be willing to open up their hearts and accept Jesus as their saviour, and experience the transformation of their lives.

**19/11 Day 14:**

Psalms 32:8 The LORD says, "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you."

The members of the Ubon Committee for this time are Pastor Xiao Wen, Elder Gary, Deacon Xin Er, Si Min, and Jing Yang. However, due to work commitments, Si Min is unable to take leave and can only assist with preparations.

After signing up for the short-term mission at the beginning of this year, our committee members have been tirelessly planning for this mission. They have established various ministries and activities, prepared individuals to plan the itinerary, and monitored the progress of all preparations.

- We pray that the Lord grants wisdom to the committee members, that they may rely on the guidance of the Holy Spirit to wisely plan and execute this short-term mission. May they be united in purpose and fulfill the mission.
- We pray that the Lord watches over all the needs of the committee members, preserves their physical, mental, and spiritual health, and grants them courage and strength to face various challenges and difficulties, experiencing God's grace and victory.
- We pray that the Lord bestows upon them discernment, enabling them to handle various situations clearly. May He help them make correct decisions that not only align with the Lord's will but also contribute to the success of this short-term mission.

#### **20/11 Day 15:**

1 Peter 4:10 Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms.

Agape Mission Team is composed of 44 members, divided into two teams serving in Ubon. Each team has activities such as drama, dance, worship (vocalists and guitarists), and games. The two teams will separately present a 1-1.5 hour Christmas outreach program with the theme "The Greatest Gift".

- We thank God for giving each team member different gifts. We pray that the Lord helps us to serve one another and support each other according to the gifts we have received, showing the world a testimony of unity in the body of Christ. May we treat each other with love and patience, resolve conflicts, dispel misunderstandings, and complete our tasks in a spirit of teamwork.
- We pray for the daily programs in Ubon, asking the Lord to take control of all our activities and lead us in the way of the Lord. May each team member fix their eyes on Jesus, obey His commands, act in love, and submit under the authority of the Lord.

#### **21/11 Day 16:**

1 Corinthians 4:9 For it seems to me that God has put us apostles on display at the end of the procession, like those condemned to die in the arena. We have been made a spectacle to the whole universe, to angels as well as to human beings.

The leaders of the drama team are Jarrod, Walter, and Jun Qiang. The members of the drama team are divided into two groups, each presenting two performance pieces: painting and drama.

- We pray that the Lord grants wisdom and strength to the leaders of the drama team to plan and present the two performance pieces: painting and drama. We pray that the members of both groups can quickly learn and master the roles they are playing. We ask for the Holy Spirit to fill each member, giving them confidence, courage, and passion, so that they not only perform their roles well, but also consider the overall presentation of the drama.
- We pray that the message conveyed through the drama may deeply penetrate the hearts of the audience. May they respond, and may their lives be transformed through their connection with Christ.

#### **22/11 Day 17:**

Psalms 30:11-12 You turned my wailing into dancing; you removed my sackcloth and clothed me with joy, that my heart may sing your praises and not be silent. LORD my God, I will praise you forever.

The leaders of the dance team are Jana, Cherin, and Gracie. The team members are also divided into two groups, each presenting a hip-hop dance and a sign language dance.

- We pray that the Lord grants wisdom and strength to the leaders of the dance team to plan and present the two performance pieces: hip-hop dance and sign language dance. We pray for the members of both groups to quickly learn and master their respective dance steps.
- We pray for a special unity within the dance team, that they may establish trusting relationships and support one another, resulting in coordinated and synchronized dance movements. May there be a special anointing during the performance, not only uplifting the atmosphere and capturing the audience's attention, but also conveying the message of the Gospel in harmony with the overall program, softening hearts and leading them to the Lord.

**23/11 Day 18:**

Psalm 35:9 Then my soul will rejoice in the LORD and delight in his salvation.

The leaders of the game team are Germaine, Jun Fa, and Hong Jun.

- We pray that the Lord grants wisdom and strength to the leaders of the game team to plan and incorporate games into the program. As team members interact with people from different communities, even without a common language, may simple and enjoyable games break down barriers between individuals, fostering friendly relationships and preparing hearts to receive the program and message we are about to present.
- We ask the Lord to grant us the ability to bring joy even in challenging environments, reflecting that we are children of God. May our smiles and laughter in the games be infectious, uplifting spirits and dispelling darkness. May Your love shine through us, and may we become vibrant witnesses of Your grace.

**24/11 Day 19:**

Psalm 150:6 Let everything that has breath praise the LORD. Praise the LORD.

The worship team leaders are Jing Ping and Shu Qi. They will lead a War Room session together with YWAM Ubon, and they will present the Good News (a mix of Thai and English). Every member of the short-term mission team will participate in the Good News presentation.

- We pray that the Lord covers the worship co-workers with the precious blood, anoints them with the Holy Spirit, and aligns the lead vocals and instrumental accompaniment. May they create a beautiful spiritual atmosphere, allowing all participating co-workers and brothers and sisters to enter into genuine and glorious worship, praising the Lord with united hearts and voices.
- We request for the glorious presence of God to fill our gathering. Through worship, may everyone attending the War Room be lifted up before the throne of God and experience His abundant grace.
- We ask for the Holy Spirit to fill and anoint our Good News team, strengthening the unity and rapport among team members. May they sing in harmony, touching the hearts of those who listen and inspiring them to further know Jesus.

**25/11 Day 20:**

Psalm 34:10 The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing.

The logistics team leaders are Deacon Xin Er, Kai Xin, Jing Yang, and Yu An. Before departure, they are responsible for the team's logistics and baggage handling, creating short-term mission handbooks, and coordinating with the meal and first aid coordinators.

During the short-term mission, they need to keep track of team members' movements, take attendance, and oversee logistics.

- We pray that the Lord grants wisdom and strength to the logistics team leaders in organizing logistical tasks, strengthening the team's preparations before departure, and providing sufficient resources and supplies.
- We ask the Holy Spirit to guide the logistics team leaders in their interactions, actions, and decisions during this short-term mission. May they receive all of God's provisions, whether it be practical needs related to the ministry such as food, accommodation, and transportation, and experience God's love and faithful provision.
- We pray that God helps the team members to see that we are not only bringing necessities for the short-term mission, but also carrying hope, love, and God's word.

**26/11 Day 21:**

Hebrews 4:2 For we also have had the good news proclaimed to us, just as they did; but the message they heard was of no value to them, because they did not share the faith of those who obeyed.

Before departure, 40 days of prayer has been prepared for the Ubon Mission (11/6-12/15) and send it to the parent and church group leaders. Prepare daily devotional materials for the team during the mission (11/17-11/21). For those under 21 years old without parents accompanying them, provide daily updates on prayer guidance and information in the parent chat group during the mission. Coordinate with the worship team regarding prayer projects in the War Room.

- We pray that the Lord leads us (Pastor Xiao Wen, Si Min, Jessie, Ru Lan) to surrender ourselves completely to God, becoming vessels for His use in obedience to the guidance of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord add to us the burden and matters of prayer, keeping us awake with a thankful heart during prayer, and enabling us to know how to watch and pray.
- May the 40 days of prayer materials that have been prepared increase our burden for Ubon and the understanding of the short-term mission for both us and our brothers and sisters in the church. May we pray together in unity, and may the Gospel prosper.
- May the team's daily morning devotions and prayers help the members maintain an intimate relationship with God, receiving a continuous flow of strength from Him. We pray for the filling of the Holy Spirit and His anointing, that during the mission, we can clearly feel that God is with us. Everything we do is empowered: our prayers are powerful, our messages are powerful, our testimonies are powerful, our worship is powerful, our fellowship is powerful, our visits are powerful, and even cooking is done with strength.

#### **27/11 Day 22:**

Hebrews 4:3 Now we who have believed enter that rest, just as God has said, "So I declared on oath in my anger, 'They shall never enter my rest.'" And yet his works have been finished since the creation of the world.

The leaders for preaching and training are Pastor Yook Ching and Pastor Xiao Wen. Before departure, they will prepare the Christmas message and the testimonies needed and send them to the staff in Ubon for translation. During the short-term mission, they will share the message (translated by the Ubon staff).

- We pray that the Lord imparts the touch of the Holy Spirit, guiding our pastors to understand God's heart for Ubon, receive divine revelations, preach the mysteries of Christ, and deliver clear messages to lead people to know Christ. May the Gospel spread throughout the land, not returning void, but accomplishing God's will.
- We ask for God's anointing upon our pastors, that every word they speak may be refined, carrying the power of the Holy Spirit. We also pray that God uses each sermon, addressing the conditions of the hearts, serving with a compassionate heart, and meeting people's practical needs.

#### **28/11 Day 23:**

1 Corinthians 4:2 Now it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful.

The financial team is led by Elder Gary, along with Eric and Li Wen. They are responsible for the financial budget, expenditures, and accounting for the short-term mission.

The photography and videography team consists of Joy and Jorayne. They are in charge of capturing photos and videos during the short-term mission and organizing and creating related videos for reporting.

- We pray that the Lord provides everything necessary for the financial needs of the short-term mission team, so that we lack nothing and have surplus to bless those in need, experiencing God's abundant grace. May God use our financial team to be faithful stewards of the Lord, managing all expenses and income of the short-term mission.
- We ask for the anointing of the Lord upon our photographers, that they may receive revelations from the Holy Spirit during the journey, capturing important moments and meaningful scenes. After the return, we also pray that the Lord grants them wisdom and ability to organize and create videos for reporting.

#### **29/11 Day 24:**

1 Corinthians 10:31 So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

The meal coordinators are Sister Yu Hui and Zhang Yu. They are responsible for planning and overseeing breakfast for the entire team during the short-term mission.

The first aid team consists of Jeenise and Zandra. They will be responsible for first aid matters during the short-term mission.

- We pray that the Lord blesses all the food, water, and resources that will be used by the short-term mission team, making them beneficial to our bodies. May the team members partake in each meal with a thankful heart, whether eating or drinking, doing everything for the glory of God. May God grant us strength, health, and a positive attitude throughout the entire journey.
- We ask the Lord to preserve our physical health, protecting us from illness and discomfort, so that we may complete our mission with vigor.

- We pray for God's protection, both during our journey and while executing our tasks. May He shield us from accidents, illnesses, and any potential dangers. We ask for healing from any illness or injury we may encounter, and pray that the Lord supports us with His grace and strength.

### **30/11 Day 25:**

Romans 10:15 And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

The members of the short-term mission team will be divided into six groups, taking six different round-trip flights. Three of the groups will arrive on the first leg of their flight in the middle of the night, requiring a transfer at the airport, and then taking another flight at dawn to reach their destination.

- Almighty God, we understand that this task may be physically and mentally challenging from the first day of departure. We pray that the Lord strengthens the team members' physical strength and endurance, enabling them to persevere until the end. Help us to smoothly clear customs and arrive at our destination safely and on time.
- We pray for the safety of the team members. Throughout each group's journey, protect them from any dangers and harm. May the team members overcome challenges along the way with unity, taking care of and supporting one another. May God guard each team member from being affected by fatigue and disturbances during the journey, preserving our physical, mental, and spiritual health and combat readiness.

### **1/12 Day 26:**

Hebrews 13:21 equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

- We thank God for His promise to equip us with all we need to do His will. We pray for the Lord to establish unity in our midst. May each team member encourage and support one another, not focusing on personal gains or losses, but collectively pursuing the mission of spreading the Gospel. ( Tow more prayer items on page 14 )

- Each one of us has been assigned different roles. We pray that the Lord humbles us, making us vessels in His hands. Whether we are distributing food or sharing the Gospel, let us remember that in the eyes of the Lord, these "small" actions hold great significance. For it is through Jesus Christ in us that we do what pleases Him.
- We ask the Lord to help us boldly and wisely share the Gospel with those who do not know Jesus. We pray that He gives us confidence and courage to pray for those in need of His mercy. May our presence be a source of comfort, allowing His love to flow through us, touching lives and healing wounds.

### **2/12 Day 27 :**

Romans 10:14b And how are they to hear without someone to proclaim him?

Romans 15:5 May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, so that with one heart and mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- God to provide Thai language interpreters who will be willing vessels to illumine God's Word together.
- God to anoint the interpreters to speak the Word of God with clarity, conviction and power.
- Pray that they will persevere with renewed joy, be encouraged and nourished by God's Word as they make it available to others.
- God to grant them greater understanding, a growing boldness based on God's truths, and a deeper submission to the Scriptures so that their work and lives may honour Him.
- Pray for the spirit of unity in this shared ministry of the preachers and interpreters, with one heart and mouth to share God's Word in the power of the Holy Spirit, glorifying our Father in heaven.

### **3/12 Day 28 :**

Philippians 2:2-4 Make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.



- Pray for rapport and like-mindedness between the Singapore and Ubon teams as they execute the programs. Pray for a closer bond where hearts and minds are aligned with God's purpose for Ubon land.
- Every leader to value others above himself and build God-honoring partnerships.
- Pray that God will bless team leaders with divine wisdom and the mind of Christ, so that they can make good decisions together with understanding and humility.

#### 4/12 Day 29 :

Ephesians 4:2-4 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called;

- As we execute the programs together, Lord to help both Singapore and Ubon team members to walk in a manner worthy of Him and His call upon our lives.
- Give us a spirit of humility, gentleness and patience, being mindful to walk in love at all times.
- Help us to be diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
- Pray for openness and boldness from both teams to connect and strengthen each other's faith and spur each other on toward love and good deeds.

#### 5/12 Day 30 :

Phil 4:19 And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

- Pray that the orientation led by the local YWAM team leader will be one that's spirit-led, that our hearts will be stirred, so all will be bold and ready to be used by God to be a blessing to the land.
- Pray for the shopping event (gifts, food and necessities for the locals and items required for games/drama) to be smooth and that there shall be divine abundant provisions.

#### 6/12 Day 31 :

1 John 5:14-15 This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.

- Pray that the Lord will grant the mission team boldness as we enter the WAR Room with YWAM team to intercede for the nations and the lost both in Ubon, Issan, Thailand and the world.
- Pray for God to direct the heart of YWAM staff to be used by God to birth a House of Prayer (HOP) as watchmen for the city.
- Pray for transformed lives, for the fire of revival to burn in our hearts, for this fire to spread to our families, our church and the nations.

#### 7/12 Day 32:

Deuteronomy 3:22 Do not be afraid of them; the LORD your God himself will fight for you.

Pray for God's children to put on the full armour of God to guard against attacks in this battlefield.

- We put on the belt of truth to protect against lies and deception.
- We put on the breastplate of righteousness to protect our hearts from the temptations we battle.
- We put the gospel of peace on our feet, so we're ready to take Your light wherever You send us this day.
- We choose to walk in the peace and freedom of Your Spirit and not be overcome by fear and anxious thoughts.
- We take up the shield of faith that will extinguish all the darts and threats hurled our way by the enemy.
- We believe in Your power to protect us and choose to trust in you.
- We put on the helmet of salvation, which covers our minds and thoughts, reminding us we are children of the day, forgiven, set free, saved by the grace of Christ Jesus.
- We take up the sword of the Spirit, your very Word, the one offensive weapon given to us for battle, which has the power to demolish strongholds, which is alive, active and sharper than any double-edged sword.

**8/12 Day 33 :**

Psalm 126:3-5 The Lord has done great things for us, and we are filled with joy. Restore our fortunes, Lord, like streams in the Negev. Those who sow with tears will reap with songs of joy.

- Thank God for the mission field in Ubon, Thailand and the great things that He will do before, during and after the mission trip. May God be glorified in every aspect of our trip.
- Thank God for His amazing works He has done in Ubon and we trust God to do it again, to pour out His Spirit in the land of Ubon and restore it like streams in the desert. Pray for God to open the floodgates of heaven with an outpouring of His blessings, to bring light to Ubon
- Thank God for YWAM Ubon team's commitment to the Great Commission. May God turn all sorrow into joy and bring a great revival to the land

**9/12 Day 34 :**

Mark 16:17-18 And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.

- Lord to anoint both teams and demonstrate His power with signs and wonders .
- In Jesus' name, we command financial increase for the Land Project to build houses for abandoned or orphaned babies.
- We command the sick to be made whole. We command the deaf to hear, the mute to speak and the lame to walk.
- We decree that God's marvelous works will follow us so that people will come to Him confessing Jesus Christ, as their Lord and Redeemer.
- With His strong hand and outstretched arm, we declare that God will manifest His glory in the land of Ubon through the hands of His people

**10/12 Day 35 :**

2 Thessalonians 3:1-2 As for other matters, brothers and sisters, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honoured, just as it was with you. And pray that we may be delivered from wicked and evil people, for not everyone has faith. But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.

- Declare that the Word of the Lord shared by both teams through the programs to the campus, homeless, villages and prison ministries may have free course.
- By God's grace and power, the gospel can spread quickly and powerfully among His children in the land
- Thank God for His faithful promises - to strengthen, establish, and protect His children
- Declare those who hear the Word of God would have faith that grows abundantly
- Pray their love will increase for each other and that they will be steadfast in persecution
- Pray for God's children who share the gospel to be delivered from any evil scheme of the enemy

**11/12 Day 36:**

2 Corinthians 10:4-5 The weapons we use in our fight are not the world's weapons but God's powerful weapons, which we use to destroy strongholds. We destroy false arguments; we pull down every proud obstacle that is raised against the knowledge of God; we take every thought captive and make it obey Christ.

- God to raise every Christian to use His weapons -declaring the truth, demonstrating love, living righteously, and walking in faith -let prayers arise with power to deliver the people of Ubon and set them free
- Pray against strongholds and extremes in culture and traditional beliefs that hold man in bondage
- Declare that Ubon land shall become the place where the Gospel of Jesus reigns and rules. Cast down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God. Bring every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ

**12/12 Day 37 :**

Colossian 2:6-7 Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude.

- Pray that everyone preached to in this mission trip will be established in faith of the Lord Jesus and pray for strength to stay on the right path, stay away from temptation and walk in the light of Your path.
- May their hearts be always thankful and desire to love God, love others, walk with Him and be rooted in His Word.

**13/12 Day 38:**

Psalms 119:10 I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands.

- Pray against the work of the devil to take away God's word from the hearts of the people preached unto.
- May God's Word be a lamp to their feet and a light to their path.
- May God's Word become their daily sustenance, and life-support, knowing that it alone can keep them in the path of righteousness.
- May God's Word teach and train them to guide others to salvation and a transformed life.

**14/12 Day 39 :**

Isaiah 55:11 God said, "My word shall not return void but accomplish all it is sent forth to do."

- Thank God for His Word that the Scriptures will not return to Him void. May the gospel shared in the land not return void but accomplish His will
- Declare every household of faith experience a divine explosion of God's goodness where captives are set free, burdens are lifted, yokes are destroyed, hearts are healed and relationships are restored.
- Declare God is doing a new thing in Ubon land to raise up many local missionaries to be sent out to other parts of Thailand
- Declare by faith, we shall see the least-reached communities of Ubon responding authentically to the gospel and being disciplined into biblically-based, community-transforming churches which engage in mission
- Declare Ubon land is crowned with God's loving kindness and its people have victory in His sight.

**15/12 Day 40 :**

Philippians 1:3-5 I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now.

- Thank God for Agape Church's partnership with YWAM Ubon in sending out short term mission team for the last 5 years
- Thank God Agape church is able to support YWAM Ubon in prayers and finances to advance the gospel in the land
- Pray God will stir more Agapians, renew our desire to share the gospel with the lost locally and overseas
- May the Lord bless Ubon and keep Ubon; the Lord make his face shine on Ubon and be gracious to Ubon; the Lord turn his face toward Ubon and give Ubon peace (Number 6:24-26)
